


The Sanctuary – Holy Place - Common Elements Which Bring Furnitures Together.

What a picture this study will give us. The key is bringing it into the life by the power of the Holy Spirit.



Golden Altar (_____) - perfume, apothecary
"pure and holy" {Ex.30:34-38}
vs. 36 - _____, very small

Some of which
was put before
the testimony of
the tabernacle

Table of Shewbread (Bread of the Presence) (_____)
Bread is made from which grows in the earth, cursed by sin
softened by tears, tilled by sweat. Isa.53:5 _____ for our iniquities
i.e. it was _____ or ground into flour by mill-stones.

Lampstand (_____) fuel = Holy Spirit
The wicks are _____ (Isa.4:4,5; cf Ezek.24:11; John 1:4,9)
which reflect the character of Christ

What is common in all three of these furnitures?

All of these natural processes—beating the incense ingredients into a perfume apothecary; crushing or grounding the grain by the mill-stones (Luke 21:49; cf. Rev 18.21,22) into fine flour for the bread. The oil for the lamps to burn or consume the wicks reflecting light through all the ministration in the holy place giving off light.

Spiritually speaking the

- Incense - Spotless Righteousness of Christ
which has been beaten into perfume
- Grain = self-sacrificing life of Jesus
ground or crushed into fine flour (John 12:24; Heb 5:8)
- Oil Olive = Holy Spirit
Crushing or beating oil out of the fruit- berries. Holy Spirit
Suffered with Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (oil press).
Christ was later at His trial, scourged twice, punched and
struck (beaten). The sufferings of Jesus was the gift of Holy Spirit.

When this oil is consumed in the wicks of those lamps it is the consuming of the flesh and blood of Christ (John 6:33,51,53,56,63) and a daily prayer life where Christ's righteousness makes our prayers acceptable to God.

Thus, God's people fitly framed together (Eph.2:21,22) growing into a holy temple in the Lord which He will use to "lighten the earth with His glory," (Rev.18:1) one last time.
