WHERE DID PAUL RECEIVE THIS REVELATION FROM? Holy Spirit gave it to him from other parts of the Bible. God is the one who justifieth! {click the pinnacle passage *God Justifieth* for more enlightenment.} Because He is the one who stands for us (Ps 82:1), since He loved us with an everlasting love (Jer 31:3); He has freely given us all things, and God defends His people (Ps 5:11). He justifieth me (Isa 50:8), who shall condemn me? (Isa 50:9). Christ was raised up to freely impart gifts to His children (Eph 4: 8,10,11), and intercedes today (Acts 5:30,31; Heb 7:25). To live for Jesus, we must first die with Him (Luke 9:23; 2 Cor 5:14; 1 Cor 15:31). Thus, we can know, He will never leave us, nor forsake us (Heb 13:5). Thus, nothing can separate us from His Love (Rom 8:35, 38, 39).
