

A Testimony of God's Greatness

Psalm 145

- A - I will extol (praise) Thee; I will bless Thy name forever and ever. -vs.1
- B - They (one generation) praise Thy works -vs. 6,7
- C - The Lord's great and tender mercies (over all His works) -vs.8,9
- D - Thy saints shall bless Thee; they speak of glory & power of His Kingdom -vs.10,11
- D - To the sons of men is made known the glorious majesty of His Kingdom -vs.12,13
- C - are evident in how He satisfies and supplies needs of His creatures -vs.15,16
{great and tender mercies}
- B - The Lord is righteous and holy (merciful) in all His ways/works -vs.17
- A - My mouth shall speak praise of the Lord: let all flesh bless His holy name. -vs.21

Mini chiasms within the chapter reveal more of the greatness of Jehovah

| a – Individual praise to God -vs.5, 6 | a – and <u>The glorious majesty of His kingdom</u> which is everlasting and His dominion throughout all generations -vs.13 |
