- A I will extol (praise) Thee; I will bless Thy name forever and ever. -vs.1
 - B They (one generation) praise Thy works -vs. 6,7
 - C The Lord's great and tender mercies (over all His works) -vs.8,9
 - D Thy saints shall bless Thee; they speak of glory & power of His Kingdom -vs.10,11
 - D To the sons of men is made known the glorious majesty of His Kingdom -vs.12,13
 - C are evident in how He satisfies and supplies needs of His creatures -vs.15,16 {great and tender mercies}
 - B The Lord is righteous and holy (merciful) in all His ways/works -vs.17
- A My mouth shall speak praise of the Lord: let all flesh bless His holy name. -vs.21

- a Individual praise to God -vs.1
 - b The greatness of God -vs.2
 - **b** Generations praise thy works -vs.3
- a Individual praise to God -vs.5, 6

Note: There are two links in the Pinnacle of the main chiasm, the "D Statements"—glory and power and glorious majesty for the purpose of shedding more light.
